# **Updates**

During our Q1 meeting, we presented the results from the website feedback survey. (Please see Q1 minutes on our website for this graphic.) The information harvested will be used to further conversations regarding upcoming changes to the Beachwalk website.

At present, there is no timeline for these changes. Your BOD wants to be thorough and thoughtful with these updates, not wanting to rush these changes. We thank you for your continued patience during this process.

Network's new system "CYNC" is another valuable resource available to our homeowners. Many have asked over the years for an online or card option for payment and this new system offers that convenience. Other features include an extensive database where residents can review minutes, financials, newsletters, access online ACC applications, access our Bylaws/C&R, and more.

As you can imagine, this is a labor intensive endeavor to upload all this data. Gaps in available data will be resolved in time as the information is uploaded into Cync.

As many of you know, the Board of Directors moved to prohibit organized classes in the pool several seasons ago. In light of concerns and complaints received by some Beachwalk residents who felt their right to use the pool were being restricted by non-Beachwalk members, the Board commenced a thorough research and analysis to better understand the complexities involved, to include other island HOA's experiences.

Through this research, we learned of another HOA who was dropped by their insurance underwriter due to these classes and the liability risk they pose. Network also has firsthand experience regarding other HOA's managed. The Board felt the risk associated with these organized classes, many of which historically were made up of non-Beachwalk residents, posed an unnecessary risk to the Association and our members.

The Board of Directors reached out to our legal counsel regarding these organized classes seeking his professional opinion. Our attorney, after reviewing the facts, current law, and considering the Board's fiscal responsibility has advised against these organized classes. His letter is attached for transparency.

It has come to our attention that there may be misinformation circulating regarding this decision to prohibit these classes. We felt it imperative to provide clarity and transparency on this matter. The decision to eliminate these classes was not made lightly and we sympathize with those upset by this decision. Sometimes difficult decisions must be made for the overall benefit and protection of the Association. That said, no Beachwalk resident is prohibited from enjoying our pool. This pertains only to organized classes.

### **Stormwater**

The anticipated stormwater maintenance project is scheduled to begin in the next two weeks.

Stormwater pipes under the following streets will be sleeved by the Town of Kure Beach. Please be advised there may be lane closures, all of which should have a minimal impact on our residents.

- under 5th Ave N
- · under Shell
- under Surf

For those "pond dwellers" along our south pond, a preventative maintenance project is in the preliminary scheduling phase. This will bring our berms and forebays back into compliance. We anticipate this project to begin in the next month or two, prior to our seasonal rains.

P.S.

Our flag responsibility is overseen by Joe Truelove, a respected veteran and previous Board President. If you see an issue related to the flags, please contact Cindy. Flags are **not** to be removed or disposed of without authorization.

There have been reports of our pond fountains being turned off. These are not to be turned off. Issues should be directed to Cindy.

One more thing...

We are pleased to announce there will be Wi-Fi accessibility at the pool/clubhouse for residents. We are improving upon our outdated system and this will be one of the upgrades to that maintenance project. Stay tuned... more information to come.

Public works is now utilizing one-arm trucks. Please place the garbage and recycling cans approximately two feet apart and closer to the road.
